Derrick informed the committee that a comment was made at yesterday's AACSC meeting that the employer number is not accurate and that programs are not required to input that info into Rapids.

Had one issue with a transfer and as of last week talked to an apprentice that was having issues getting their hours and that his employer has pulled all of their apprentices from the program. He thinks that an update of the rules could be done to address these issues. OSD has already decommitted their funding for FY23 in January.

Year slowing down. The AACSC approved the way the remaining TA funds will be disbursed out to all programs based on the percentage that can be applied to all programs. We have more apprentices this year than what we had in the past. Conversation will be taking place this month about the funding guidelines. CT funds have already been approved to move to 100% reimbursement after being able to do it this year.
