DRAFT DAY EVENT

Draft Day will provide two different areas for students to connect with companies:

The first, a traditional-style **Career Expo** to visit will be on site. High School students of all ages are invited to participate in Career Exploration while engaging with local companies. Students are encouraged to prepare questions and resumes to hand out to participating companies.

The second, **Interview Sessions** – Student (Seniors) interests and aptitudes data is used to match them with employers based on identified categories of need. This strategic pairing, as well as resources provided in advance to prepare students for interviews, resume writing and interviewing, maximizes opportunities for high-value interactions for all involved.

We suggest **bringing five (5) team members** to the event: three (3) interviewers & two (2) for your Meet & Greet booth.

PREPARING EMPLOYERS FOR DRAFT DAY

The Arkansas Office of Skills Development is a key to Draft Days' overall success. We will host a meeting, local to each Draft Day event, between January and March to inform participating employers about resources available to offset costs associated with onboarding and training talent for your advanced technical needs.

"My favorite experience was seeing the excitement of the students who interviewed after they finished. They were all positive, encouraged, and anticipating follow ups."



DRAFT DAY PREP: SENIORS

Four (4) Workshops to support student success will begin as soon as possible as follows:

YOUSCIENCE ASSESSMENT

The first piece of preparing for Draft Day comes in the form of the YouScience Interest and Aptitude Assessment. Students will complete the 90-minute assessment then receive detailed, personalized results to give them an idea of careers they already have a natural bent toward. The YouScience assessment can assist students in tailoring their search for the jobs and companies they'd like to interview with.

WORKSHOP 1: RESUME BUILDING

After taking their YouScience assessment, students will receive instruction on how to build a resume. The guidelines for resume building will have students in mind, not 20-year veterans of a field, to help the students best learn how to frame and leverage their academic, volunteer, and/or part-time work. Once the student has their resume and YouScience results in hand, our workshop will address job readiness skills like important documentation to have access to.

WORKSHOP 2: INTERVIEW READINESS

The second Draft Day Workshop will include resume writing and review, and basic interview prep. Interview preparation will include best practices on attire, how early to arrive, what kinds of questions you'll be expected to answer, and more.

WORKSHOP 3: MOCK INTERVIEWS

The third Draft Day Workshop will include mock interviews held by the workshop hosts. Students will have the chance to participate in both the interviews and a group discussion over what they learn from each mock interview. Finally, the workshop hosts will review the company profiles and address any questions students may have about the participating companies. Having the chance to practice interview skills beforehand, in addition to knowing their skills, having a professional resume, and knowing how to communicate all give students the best chance at having a stress-free and, most importantly, successful interview at their Draft Day event. Our goal with the workshop process is to help students feel confident and prepared to attend Draft Day, find a career that will last a lifetime, and make the transition from high school to hired.

WORKSHOP 4: PROFESSIONAL READINESS

Workshop 4 will focus on business communication etiquette, such as how to write a professional email, the importance of thank-you notes, social media usage, how to set up a voicemail, and how to make a professional phone call. Online applications have become difficult to navigate and understand, so our workshop will walk students through the different kinds of applications (Indeed, company-built, etc.) and how to fill them out properly. We will also cover topics such as shift work and schedules, tobacco policies, uniforms and ID's versus drivers licenses. Finally, students will have the opportunity to learn about the companies that will be attending their local Draft Day event. This overview will include a brief history of the company, what positions the company is hiring for, their locations, and more.
