Meeting called to order at 12:30 pm on November 4th, by Chairwoman Breashears (via Zoom)

Previous Month's Meeting Minutes:

-There was a motion by Nanci Caillouet and a 2nd by Kathy Fulks to approve the minutes from the October meeting as presented. Motion passed.

U.S. DOL-OA, Mr. Prather reported:

Begins at the 2:20 minute mark

- -November $15^{th} 19^{th}$ is National Apprenticeship Week. Please register any and all events you have planned, on the website.
- -Referred to the recording of last month's minutes and wanted to make clear that USDOL-OA does not want, nor try, to take any credit for the growth of apprenticeship in the state. Regarding last years growth, of the 3008 new apprentices, 2,764 were in construction, 161 in IT, and 83 in manufacturing.

- -Stated that Mark and Rocky have been really good about inviting him to meetings with possible new programs, employers, etc.
- -Reiterated that apprenticeship in this state is a total team effort.

- -8:03 minute mark. Kathy Fulks stated that in an October meeting with Secretary Preston, OSD had referenced 13 employers/companies currently waiting to get their standards approved. Mr. Prather stated that OSD has weekly expansion meetings and there are 64 different entities talking with them about apprenticeship. Currently there are no entities waiting on USDOL-OA approval. Some are working on getting their standards in order. None have completed applications and are waiting.
- -Kathy Fulks asked if he was in talks with these entities to assist them through the process. Mr. Prather said yes.

Mark McManus reported: Begins at the 10:15 minute mark

- -OSD will be hosting a virtual healthcare employer forum on November 15th. Close to 100 people have pre-registered.
- -The video, that has been in the works with Arkansas PBS, will feature six different employers from various areas in the state. Hopefully, it will be ready in time for National Apprenticeship Week. Once it is ready, OSD will send out a link for everyone to see it.

OSD-OA, Mr. Mantooth reported: Begins at the 14:00 minute mark

-Amount of TA funds sent out \$310,892.50 thru the end of September.

- -Amount of CT funds approved to date \$215,213.88 and of that \$136,241.63 has been disbursed. See attached list of disbursements.
- -Schools are doing a great job of keeping up with their paperwork and receipts.
- -With the end of the semester fast approaching, please be mindful of the dates to remember.
- -15:30 minute mark. Director Waits discussed his response letter to last months committee action. He will be re-looking at the motion that was passed and making sure his letter matches the motion. A copy of his original letter was sent out to members following last months meeting.
- -17:04 minute mark. Nanci Caillouet stated that during the meeting with Secretary Preston, the Secretary asked for a cost benefit analysis. She went on to ask if OSD had began working on that. Director Waits stated that they have not began that process because at this time there is zero cost to transition.
- -18:50 minute mark. NWA Build My Future Grant Application. Director Waits reported on conversations OSD has had with contractors in the Northwest Arkansas area regarding Build My Future. You can google Build My Future Springfield, Missouri for look at what this could bring to Northwest Arkansas. There was a discussion about the possibility of the AACSC using outreach and education funds to assist. Attached are the documents Bill Roachell emailed to the committee, which includes sponsorship and exhibitor forms.
