## **Approval of Minutes from March 2, 2023:**

Derrick brought to the SPAC's attention that an apprentice had been released to test by NWA Mechanical after the SPAC had approved experienced credit back in November of 2022. Derrick wanted confirmation from the SPAC that they were ok with this apprentice being provided experienced credit since they had already been attending a program in Arkansas previously and then had left the state, not attended school where they were, then came back to the state and requested experienced credit. The apprentice was employed by the same company the entirety of the time and the Program informed Derrick that they do this all the time. The SPAC agreed that the situation was OK and had no issues with it.

 NATF brought the Modern Plumbing Curriculum to the SPAC for curriculum reimbursement approval. The information provided was reviewed by the committee. This curriculum would only have to be purchased for an apprentice one time, one book for 4 years. If approved it would not be reimbursable until July 1, 2023. There was a motion by Corser and a second by Dewey to table it for vote until the May meeting. The SPAC voted to table until May. Breashears abstained.
