certification. They have been having issues with their ratio's. The State and Federal requirements differ.

Heath Harris requested discussion with the SPAC and Ric Mayhan about the renewal process. Currently, the apprentice plumber renewal forms are being sent directly to the apprentice. Heath says that their program is having issues making sure that their apprentices are keeping up with their renewals. He was requesting that the renewal forms be sent directly to the apprenticeship program if possible. Ric said that they had issues with that process when they had tried it before. He said they are also required by law to keep up with the apprentices addresses and that was one of the reasons they do not like sending it to the program. They were not always being updated by the programs the apprentices address changes. ADH will be keeping it the way it is at this time. He's open to suggestions but has not found a better way. Heath asked about modifying the application to have multiple addresses. He said that he would have to talk it over with his department. Ric said there is also issues with notifying license holders for failure to pay child support. That is put on their shoulders by law to make those phone calls to the license holder. He suggested to verify the license is current by going to the web site and check their apprentices.
